**Footnote 1:**  
Fit depends on chainstay width. You must have enough space for the inner guide ring to clear the chainstay. If in doubt, get the System 3 Mini-Me.

**Footnote 2:**  
Although the System 2 will fit elevated chainstay bikes, it is not necessary. If you are shopping for a new chain guide, the System 3 or System 1 is a better choice for elevated chainstay frames.
